There was a tense finish for Rangers however as Donyatt got another goal from a quickly taken free kick - but the home side held on to take all 3 points. Cameron and debutant Lewis Fisher, signed from Misterton the day before, took the man of the match accolades.

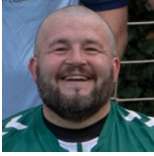
Congratulations to Josh Hayne who made his 100th appearance for Crewkerne Rangers in last Saturday's 3-2 win over Donyatt United.

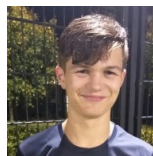

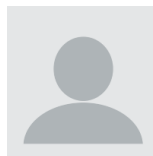

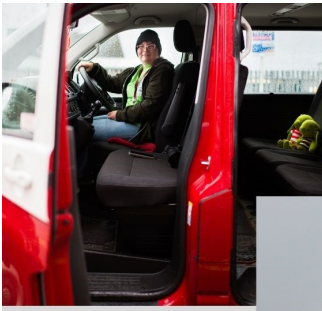
