First Team 8 – 2 Charmouth**02/09/23 | PSDL Div 1**

It was an excellent start to Jamie Stewart's tenure as manager of the First Team, with a resounding victory over Charmouth. Crewkerne came out of the blocks quickly, and took control of the game with 6 first half goals - Liam Bagwell netting from the spot, midfield maestro Tyler Cullingford with a brace, Callum Newton making an instant impact from the bench finishing from a delightfully chipped Simon Livy pass and 17 year old debutant Alex Lanc scoring with his first touch. The other goal being an own goal with the Charmouth defender turning home a dangerous Tom Rennie cross with both Livy and Bagwell waiting to slot home. The visitors got a goal back early in the second half, but another own goal through an unfortunate deflection off the defender after an excellent save from the Charmouth keeper restored the 6 goal lead. Charmouth got their second of the game with 15 minutes to go, but the scoring was finished off by young lanc again tucking home from close range after an unselfish cut back from Newton.

Combe started well but Crewkerne grew into the game and went 1-0 up with a nice finish from Tommy Martin following a good ball from Steve Cross. Rangers then went 2-0 up with the pre-match game plan coming to fruition - dead ball specialist Steve Cross put the ball on the keeper and big Andy Loveless was there to head it home! Combe got a goal back, and new Rangers stopper Chris Matthews made a great save to keep it at 2-1 at half time. Combe found their equaliser early in the 2nd half however to make it 2-2, but substitute Liam Mackle on his debut scored with a lovely finish to make it 3-2. Rangers held on until the final 5 minutes when Combe equalised with a brilliant header from a corner, final score 3-3.

First Team 4 – 0 Misterton Reserves**06/09/23 | PSDL Div 1**

The first midweek game of the season was a crunch local derby with Misterton Reserves at Henhayes. Matches between the 2 sides are usually highly charged, and can often result in cagey affairs - but that wasn't the case this time. Crewkerne took control of the early exchanges, with Matt Adams hitting the post and visiting keeper Nathan Turnbull pulling off a number of excellent stops. Mizzy grew into the game, and after the first drinks break carved out the best chance of the game with a missed 1v1 from close range, and then drawing Rangers stopper Jamie Stewart into 2 good saves. Half time, 0-0.

Misterton had the better of the opening 15 minutes of the second half, but once Crewkerne got back on the ball they took the lead through Liam Bagwell. Adams quickly doubled the lead before the 2nd drinks break with a composed finish. Misterton had a man sent off for striking Callum Newton in the face just after the restart following a heated exchange, and Crewkerne quickly took advantage with Tyler Cullingford neatly setting up Adams for his second. An excellent performance from Matt Adams was rounded off with a delicate lob to seal his hat-trick and all 3 points for Rangers, final score 4-0. 03/09/23 | SCWL Div 2S

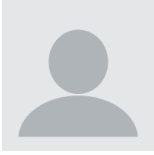
